CSB's Dick Myers honored

Richard W. Myers, a director of Citizens State Bank since 1977, was named New Castle's 1985 Citizen of the Year by the chamber of commerce. The award was presented during the group's annual meeting in March.

"As chairman of an assortment of fund drives in Henry County, Dick has been responsible for the collection of close to a half a million dollars," said Dr. Jeri Horn, who made the presentation. "He gives a lot of himself and somehow gets others to do the same."
